INVOLUNTARY SUSPENSION OF THE BBS LIMITED (BBS) BOND “BBS005” FROM TRADING ON THE BSE

For Immediate Release on 12 April 2021 – Following the halt on trading of BBS005 bond on 07 April 2021, the public is hereby informed that the BBS005 bond has now been suspended from trading on the BSE with immediate effect in accordance with section 17.3 of the BSE Trading Rules (Trading Rules).

Section 17.3 of the trading rules states that **“The maximum allowable period for a trading and security halt shall not exceed 3 trading days”**.

Therefore, since BBS005 has been on a trading halt for 3 trading days, the

bond shall now be suspended as guided by the Trading Rules.

BBS Equity Securities registered on the BSE Serala OTC Board remain halted.

Both securities will be reinstated for trading once BBS has published the full details providing clarity on the matter on X-News.
