CAUTIONARY ANNOUNCEMENT

In terms of section 5.4(c) of the Botswana Stock Exchange Equity Listings Requirements, an issuer is required to publish a cautionary announcement as soon as it is satisfied that a reasonable degree of certainty exists that the expected financial results for the upcoming period to be reported upon will differ by at least 10% from the most recent financial results for the previous corresponding period.

Following the Company's previous updates regarding the proposed sale of certain subsidiaries in East and West Africa, the relevant subsidiaries continue to be classified as discontinued operations in accordance with IFRS 5: Non-current Assets Held for Sale and Discontinued Operations. The results of these operations are included in the Group's consolidated profit after tax.

The Board of Letshego Africa Holdings Limited advises shareholders that the Group's consolidated profit after tax for the six months ended 30 June 2026 is expected to be between 20% and 30% (BWP36 million to BWP54 million) higher than the BWP181.0 million reported for the six months ended 30 June 2025.

The Group's unaudited financial results for the six months ended 30 June 2026 are expected to be released on 18 August 2026, at which time further details regarding the Group's performance will be provided.

The information contained in this announcement represents a preliminary assessment based on the information currently available and has not been audited.

Shareholders and potential investors are accordingly advised to exercise caution when dealing in the Company's securities until the financial results are formally released.
